RED ALERT: TRAFFIC SAFETY

Now that we are into the darker days of a blustery fall, it is critical to reiterate our traffic safety requirements for all people dropping off and picking up children at Aubrey!

Our children's SAFETY is more important than your CONVENIENCE!

- "Drop-Off & Pick-Up Zone" is located on Stratford Street ONLY.
- When in the "Zone", you must remain in your vehicle. DO NOT STOP in the coned areas for any reason.
- **U-Turns ARE NOT permitted in ANY school zone** (this includes pulling into a driveway to turn around!) Decide which direction you want to be pointing before you get to the area.
- Reversing for ANY REASON is illegal in a school zone.
- SLOW DOWN! Be patient! Consider parking at Kensington Community Centre!
- Please cross with your children at the marked crosswalk, even if it's out of your way. Be a role model for the students!
- Please share these regulations with anyone who will be dropping-off or picking-up your child.

Did you know: **Verbally abusive language is assault, and will not be tolerated.** If this kind of behaviour is witnessed at Aubrey, the matter will be forwarded to police.

Safety is up to all of us. If you see anyone driving dangerously or behaving aggressively in the school zone, please report what you see to the school.
