TRAFFIC AND PARKING REMINDERS

We appreciate the help of Burnaby RCMP constables who came to Aubrey Elementary recently to help remind drivers of the traffic protocols around the school, and who will come again soon. We thank all families for reviewing the parking signs and regulations closest to Aubrey, especially:



NO PARKING ZONE - Stratford Avenue, the road the school is on, is NO PARKING on the school side of the road. This means you cannot leave your vehicle here to go pick-up your child. If your child is too young to come to your car on their own, this area is not for you and you are asked to park father away to walk to the school.



NO STOPPING ZONE - these are the zones closest to the crosswalks and are well marked with signs. If you stop your vehicle here, even for a short time, then other drivers cannot see children approaching or crossing in the crosswalks, which is very dangerous. **Please do not stop here for any reason!**
