Recycle for the PAC

The Aubrey PAC has an account with the **Return-it Depot at Kensington Square** which means you can bring your beverage containers directly to them and donate your deposit to support the PAC!

Here's how it works:

1. Bring your recyclables to the [Kensington Square Return-It Depot](#) and use the Express System (located on the left wall of the depot).
2. Enter "**604-664-8781**" (Aubrey PAC account) and select the number of bags you are dropping off.
3. Place the printed labels on your bags and drop them off in the express system bin.

CPF Burnaby Chapter School Representative Wanted

The CPF representative's most important role is to communicate information about CPF Burnaby to their school from the CPF Burnaby Board of Directors.

The school contacts are the French Teacher liaison and the Principal.

It is also important to communicate with the parents at their school about CPF Burnaby.

This would include things like information about upcoming meetings, events and membership. The meeting minutes are available if a meeting cannot be attended. Access to a computer is recommended since this is the main way the chapter members communicate with each other.

To be able to communicate this information, the CPF rep is encouraged to:

- attend the monthly CPF meetings. These meetings are usually held at Seaforth, Sperling, Inman or Marlborough Elementary schools in the evening.
- inform parents about CPF membership, meetings and to bring CPF brochures to their school and display them for parents.
- attend the school PAC meetings to relay information about CPF to the PAC and the parents attending those meetings.
- Add meeting, event information to the school newsletter
- Find other parents who would like to volunteer and help out at CPF events.
- Get feedback from teachers and students after attending a CPF organized event.
