Did you know?

The Aubrey PAC has an account with the **Return-it Depot at Kensington Square** which means you can bring your beverage containers directly to them and donate your deposit to support the PAC!

Here's how it works:

- Bring your recyclables to the <u>Kensington Square Return-It Depot</u> and use the Express System (located on the left wall of the depot).
- 2. Enter "604-664-8781" (Aubrey PAC account) and select the number of bags you are dropping off.
- **3.** Place the printed labels on your bags and drop them off in the express system bin.
