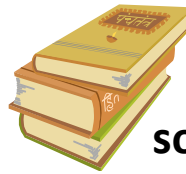

Aubrey parents are hosting the annual **Staff Appreciation Lunch** on Wednesday, **June 4**.

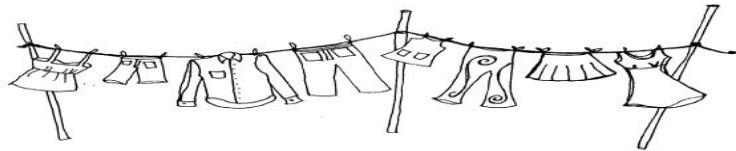
