CPR Certification Night December 5 6:30-9:30pm in the Gym



The American Heart Association states that *about 92 percent of sudden cardiac arrest victims die before reaching the hospital, but statistics prove that if more people knew CPR, more lives could be saved. Immediate CPR can double, or even triple, a victim's chance of survival!*

Come get your certification in this lifesaving technique all while supporting the PAC. Training will be provided by Alan McGrath of Life-Tech, an authorized Red Cross training partner. Alan McGrath also has 20 years of first responder experience.

Space is limited to 20 participants. 15 adults and 5 students grade 6 and up may participate.

The cost is \$40 per adult and \$25 per student.
